This position requires a strong understanding of both design process and construction execution, allowing the Project Manager to anticipate challenges, support decision-making, and maintain momentum across all phases of work.

Reporting & Collaboration

The Project Manager reports to the Managing Director for operational oversight and works in close partnership with Designers and Lead Designers throughout the life of a project. Collaboration with the Principal ensures that design intent is upheld as projects move through documentation, procurement, and installation.

The role also requires consistent coordination with architects, contractors, consultants, vendors, and custom workrooms, representing Stone Interiors with professionalism and clarity.
