- Assist with material research, finish selections, and precedent studies
- Participate in design discussions, reviews, and critiques
- Implement feedback with care, consistency, and a willingness to revise
- Support coordination with internal teams, consultants, vendors, and workrooms
- Assist with procurement and custom fabrication tasks as directed
